IALPA's interest in the the paper is solely from the point of view of safety and security. We are involved with the DAA on such matters on an ongoing basis and would therefore be concerned of the effects on such areas should the airport charges be fixed at a level lower than that preferred by the DAA.

Funding set aside for airside facilities such as lighting systems for the prevention of runway incursions and airside security are of paramount importance and to this end we would ask you to consider these factors when determining the maximum level of airport charges.
