The Incoming Tour Operators Association (ITOA) welcomes the opportunity to make a submission to the Commission of Aviation Regulation as part of the Dublin Airport economic regulatory process.

The Incoming Tour Operators Association (ITOA) is the representative association of Ireland's premier inbound tour operators. The primary focus and objective of every ITOA member company is to promote and sell the Island of Ireland as a leisure and business tourism destination through the international travel trade distribution channel. They package and bundle every element of the tourism sector in a creative and dynamic way and deliver the best standards of service to their customers and their clients.

In reviewing the draft determination, the ITOA is very concerned by the Commission's decision to disallow several key capital investment projects that are fundamental to facilitating passenger growth at Dublin Airport. In particular, increasing the runway trigger to 25m passengers will we understand result in a delay in the provision of this vital infrastructure and consequently limits the airport's ability to introduce certain long-haul flights. Having direct access to long-haul markets and increasing direct connectivity to Ireland is of fundamental importance to ITOA members and to the Irish economy as a whole.

Of further concern, several of the other proposals made by the Commission for Aviation Regulation could lead to industrial action. Interrupted operations at Dublin Airport, would undermine and damage the work of the ITOA in selling and promoting Ireland as a reliable and attractive destination.
