


This report evaluates the performance of Dublin Airport in Q1 2018 in relation to the quality of service standards set by the Commission in the 2014 Determination.

A total of 12 targets are monitored, including security queue wait times, baggage handling facilities and passenger survey results.

Dublin Airport met all targets in Q1 2018.
