With reference to our application for approval of an ATI fee for CUPPS (Common User Passenger Processing System) equipment usage at Cork Airport on 30 November 2015 and your notice of 15 January 2016 daa herewith submits the following response.

Compliance with Criteria for ATI Fees

Our application for ATI fee approval for CUPPS equipment at Cork Airport of €0.13 per departing passenger followed completion of a consultation with users on the CUPPS equipment charge at Cork Airport. In the consultation paper issued as part of the consultation process we illustrated that the charge mechanism and charge level proposed is consistent with the criteria set out in the 1996 Ground-handling Directive for the setting of ATI fees: relevancy, objectivity, transparency and non-discrimination.

Consultation with Airport Users


daa undertook the following consultation process with users in relation to the charge for CUPPS equipment at Cork Airport:

Action	Date
Consultation paper issued	11 November 2015
Deadline for final written comments from users - Two user responses were received	25 November 2015
daa issued response to consultation including the revised CUPPS charge for which application would be made to CAR for approval	30 November 2015
daa applied to CAR for approval of the revised ATI fee for use of CUPPS at the level specified in the response to consultation	30 November 2015

No user expressed disagreement with regard to the fulfilment of the four necessary criteria for the fee proposed.

Conclusion

We therefore submit that approval be granted for an ATI fee for CUPPS equipment at Cork Airport of €0.13 per departing passenger.
