## Introduction

- 1.1 The Commission is responsible for the declaration of coordination parameters at Dublin Airport for each summer and winter season. The decision making process includes extensive engagement with the Dublin Airport Coordination Committee and the generation of evidence (such as simulation modelling and consideration of recent landside and airside performance).
- 1.2 This note sets out the timeline for the decisions on the parameters for Winter 2020 and Summer 2021. As previously, it is based on the IATA deadline for confirmation of the coordination parameters (Day X). We have otherwise maintained the timelines from 2019, in which we sought to balance the needs of various stakeholders while allowing sufficient time for a thorough and collaborative assessment of the best available evidence.
- 1.3 The Commission intends to update and validate the Fast Time Simulation airfield model, developed ahead of the Summer 2018 declaration, in order to help inform the decision on appropriate coordination parameters. A forecast 'busy day' flight schedule for the season in question will then be simulated, and we will assess the simulation outputs. This exercise requires a forecast schedule, which is informed by airline plans.
