The Commission has published a draft report by Helios Technologies Ltd on the assessment it is carrying out in relation to the capacity of Dublin Airport. The purpose of this assessment is to assist the Commission in declaring Slot Coordination parameters for future seasons. The report assesses the following:

- Runway and airspace capacity
- Taxiway and stand capacity
- Firebreaks in the flight schedule
- Coordinating to five minute periods, rather than ten minute periods
- Passenger terminal building capacity
- Road access

The report is published alongside this consultation document. We invite submissions in response to the draft report no later than **17 November 2017**. Responses should be evidence based. They should be titled “Response to Capacity Assessment at Dublin Airport” and sent by email to info@aviationreg.ie or by post to: Commission for Aviation Regulation, 3rd Floor, Alexandra House, Earlsfort Terrace, Dublin D02 W773.
