With regard to the abovementioned Consultation Paper and paragraph 6.3 (Slot Allocation and Coordination) in particular, Lufthans wishes to make the following comments.

Lufthansa supports the approach, that the levy should be allocated in a certain proportion (i.e. 30/70) between the Airport Operator and the National Air Carriers, as it is applied in most of the EU Countries.

However, as to the methodology used to recover expenditures incurred for slot coordination matters, the levy should be devided between the National Carriers in the proportion of their number of movements at the airport.

Furthermore, in order to have complete transparency, the budget for the cost of slot allocation shall be open and subject to review by the ones who carry the costs.
