Re: Submissions on Review of Airport Charges

A chara

Aer Arann believes that there are substantial grounds for review of the following airport charges:

- (a) aircraft parking charges
- (b) passenger security process and charges
- (c) passenger transfer process between aircraft and terminal building, poor utilization of boarding buses, a facility should exist for sharing resources between airlines not on contact stands.
- (d) Runway congestion at peak times, when a second suitable runway is available but not used.
- (e) Remote aircraft parking positions which increase turnaround times and take significant additional resources to handle flights.
- (f) No facility for aircraft to park and taxi out under own power (unlike Cork) adding extra costs for provision of push backs.
- (g) Congestion at entrance to boarding gates due to insufficient security staff manning screening facilities.
