## **Dublin ATC (IAA) Response to Commission Notice 2/2007**

The Irish aviation Authority provides air traffic control services at Dublin Airport; our response to the questions posed by the Commission is as follows:

It is the IAA belief that there is an excess of demand over the stated Summer 2007 wish-list at Dublin Airport; indeed, the Commission Notice demonstrates in both Table 1 and Table 2 that demand exceeds capacity at varying points during the day

We believe that this may give rise to significant delays, which would appear to be borne out by Table 3. As a result, Dublin airport requires coordination for the 2007 summer season otherwise the agreed and acceptable 10 minute delay will be exceeded.
