Statement from the Commissioner for Aviation Regulation regarding JetGreen Airways

The Commission for Aviation Regulation confirmed today that it has been informed by JetGreen Airways, a licensed tour operator, of its decision to cease trading immediately.

The bond, which is a licensing requirement, will be called down as necessary and will be administered by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of the Transport (Tour Operators and Travel Agents) Act, 1982.

Passengers who are stranded should attempt to make alternative arrangements to return to Ireland, and submit a claim for refund to the Commission.

Passengers who have paid for cancelled flights have been advised by JetGreen to contact their credit card company, travel insurer or travel agent in the first instance. Passengers who are unable to secure a refund may make a claim to the Commission.
