## Re: **REVIEW OF TRAVEL TRADE LEGISLATION**

Dear Mr.O'Connor,

I would like to submit the following suggestions regarding the Review of Travel Trade Legislation:

- 1. The distinction should be made between sole trading/family licenced business and incorporated companies.
- 2. Provision should be made for the orderly hand-over of business to a family member, in the event of the named licensee's incapacitation or death. This should allow ongoing business to be transacted in a seamless fashion, without any complications.
- 3. In the event of a necessary claim by a client against the bond, the invoices being furnished by the travel agent should be gross invoices (i.e. including commissions earned by the travel agent)
- 3. In the event of an airline collapse, there is the question of money in the pipeline and money already accounted for in the IATA/BSP system.
