DUBLIN AIRPORT (EIDW) - CONSTRUCTION OF RECONFIGURED TAXIWAYS F-INNER, C, DN & DS

This Supplement details the construction works on F-INNER abeam Stand 119, Link 6, and North Apron abeam Stands 111, which will be carried as part of the Northern Section of the Critical Taxiways project, in order to facilitate the future reconfiguration of the taxiways F-INNER, C, DN & DS.

The planned dates of the works are from 23rd February 2023 to April 2023.

Works will be undertaken during night-time hours:

- 23:00 to 04:00 (local time) Monday to Friday nights – ending 04:00 (local time) Saturday.

The location of the works and an indicative layout of the impacted taxiways are shown in Appendix 1 to this supplement. These areas will be further subdivided in smaller working areas to minimize operational impact.

When works are undertaken in a particular area, the following taxiways will be temporarily withdrawn from service on a sequential basis:

- TWY F-Inner
- TWY C
- TWY DN & DS

The impacted taxiways will be returned to operation at 04:00 (local time) each morning.

Working Areas will be marked and lighted as necessary. If Low Visibility Conditions occur or are forecast to occur during planned working hours, work will not be carried out.

The exact operational restrictions, including dates and times, will be promulgated by NOTAM with reference to this Supplement.

Further supplements will be issued in due course, with details of the final layout of the reconfigured taxiways.
