FLIGHT RESTRICTION NOTICE

**Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Stradbally, Co. Laois
Electric Picnic Music Festival
2nd September to 5th September inclusive 2016**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 11 & 16 and Rule 9 of Part II of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2004 (S.I. No. 72/2004) and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows: -

A restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft, including Small Unmanned Aircraft as defined in S.I. 563/2015, shall apply in the vicinity of Electric Picnic Music Festival, Stradbally, Co. Laois in the Airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:	Circle radius of 2.0 NM centred on 53°00'33" N, 007°09'58" W
Vertical limits:	SFC to 2000 feet AMSL
Duration:	The period of the restriction shall be from 0500hrs UTC September 2 nd to 0800hrs UTC September 5 th 2016

The Purpose of the TRA:

The purpose of the TRA, within which flight restrictions may apply, is to ensure the safety of aircraft operating into and out of the Electric Picnic Music Festival, Stradbally, and of other air traffic operating in the vicinity of the TRA in the period cited.

Airspace Classification & ATS Service Provision:

The airspace contained within the TRA shall be classified as ICAO Class G. The ATS Service within the TRA will be a Flight Information Service (FIS) provided as follows:

Shannon FIS Frequency 127.500 MHz.

Pilots should be aware of the proximity of this TRA in relation to EIP 8 (Prohibited Area) and its location within Military Operating Area (MOA) 4.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

Subject to any decision of the Flight Operations Department of the Irish Aviation Authority to the contrary, the Airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the Event Organiser (Ms. Ange Goliger, 01- 4375750/ agoliger@festivalrepublic.com).

Small Unmanned Aircraft (SUA's) including drones and rockets, operating privately or under Aerial Works Permission may not operate within the TRA without written Permission from the Flight Operations Department and Event Organisers. SUA's may be subject to seizure by An Garda Síochána as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of Aviation Safety.

Any exemptions, alleviations or permissions, granted to Civil General Air Traffic by the Authority, are not valid within this Temporary Restricted Area during the period cited.

State Aircraft and Aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction but will make every reasonable attempt to contact Shannon FIS before entering.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the TRA activation.
