Navigational Warning Area in the vicinity of The Royal Hospital Kilmainham, Dublin Sunday July 10<sup>th</sup> 2016 from 1000 UTC to 1145 UTC

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 11 and 16 and Rule 9 of Part II of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2004 (S.I. No. 72 of 2004), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:-

A Navigational Warning on the flying of aircraft shall apply in the vicinity of The Royal Hospital Kilmainham, Dublin in the Airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:	Radius of 1NM centred on 53°20'35"N, 006°18'43"W
Vertical limits:	SFC to 2000 feet AMSL
Duration:	1000 UTC -1145 UTC on Sunday 10th July 2016

The purpose of the Navigational Warning is to ensure that Dublin ATC avoid routing aircraft over the lateral and vertical limits of the Airspace (specified above) throughout the duration of the National Day of Commemoration Ceremony.


Remotely Piloted Air Systems (RPAS) e.g. drones, operating privately or under Aerial Work Permissions are not permitted to operate within the NWA without written Permission from the Flight Operations Authority and Event Organisers. RPAS may be subject to seizure by An Garda Siochana as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of Aviation Safety.

State Aircraft and Aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.

Any exemptions, alleviations or permissions, granted to Civil General Air Traffic by the Authority, are not valid within this Navigational Warning Area during the period cited.

NOTAM's have been issued to notify of the Navigational Warning Area activation.
