Request for Comment: Establishment of a General Aviation Safety Council for Ireland - Extension to

Closure Date for Comment

1. PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

The purpose of this document is to advise all stakeholders of the intention of the IAA to extend the closure date for comment to the Request for Comment: Establishment of a General Aviation Safety Council for Ireland document which was posted on the IAA website on 16 December 2010.

2. INTRODUCTION

Following approaches from several general aviation organisations and members of the general aviation community requesting an extension to the closing date for comment on the Request for Comment: Establishment of a General Aviation Safety Council for Ireland, it has been agreed that the closure date for comment will be extended and the new closure date will be Sunday, 31 July 2011.

3. DETAIL

One of the principle reasons for extending the deadline is to allow the National Aero Club of Ireland to hold a series of briefings/open meetings at various venues throughout the country to brief members of the GA community on the concept and purpose of the proposed GASCI.
