## Navigational Warning Area in the vicinity of Foynes, County Limerick on the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2016 from 1400 to 1630 UTC Daily

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of articles 11 and 16 and Rule 9 of Part II of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2004 (S.I. No. 72 of 2004), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited areas and restricted areas), hereby directs as follows:-

A navigational warning on the flying of aircraft shall apply in the vicinity of **Foynes, County Limerick** in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits: Circle 1.5NM Radius centred on 52°37'03.000"N 009°06'45.000"W

**Vertical limits:** SFC to 2000 feet AMSL.

**Duration:** 1400-1630 UTC Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2016

The purpose of the navigational warning is to ensure the safety of aircraft participating in Foynes Airshow in the Foynes area and of other air traffic operating in the vicinity of Limerick in the periods cited.

Subject to any decision of Shannon ATC to the contrary, the navigational warning area is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the Foynes Airshow Organisers and in accordance with instructions, conditions and in coordination with the Irish Aviation Authority ANS Operations & Strategy Shannon Airport.

State aircraft and aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.

NOTAM's have been issued to notify of the navigational warning area activation
