Request for Comment: EC Directive on Occurrence Reporting in Civil Aviation

1. PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

The IAA wish to bring to the attention of all interested stakeholders a public consultation on a possible revision of Directive 2003/42/EC on occurrence reporting in civil aviation and of its implementing rules. Any change to the Directive may impact Statutory Instrument SI 285 of 2007 European Communities (Occurrence Reporting in Civil Aviation) Regulations 2007.

2. DETAIL

The European Commission had started the process of revision of the Directive 2003/42/EC through the "Public consultation on a possible revision of Directive 2003/42/EC on occurrence reporting in civil aviation and of its implementing rules".
