**Title: Guidance Material on Special Events Aviation Activities**

## **1 INTRODUCTION**

Special Events Activity is an event, which is either aviation related or non-aviation related, and which draws large numbers of people on certain dates at different locations around Ireland. These events have historically attracted general aviation activity in large numbers.

## **3 DETAIL**

A Temporary Airspace (TA) may be established by the Irish Aviation Authority for certain events. This can be promulgated by means of an AIP Supplement, put on the IAA Web Site or via the NOTAM system with operational times and dates.

Prior Permission (PPR) to Approach, Land, Take-off within the defined area of the event and / or transition any TA established for such an event, must be obtained from the Flight Operations Department, Irish Aviation Authority and the pertinent Special Event Organisers.

Safety surveillance and oversight by the Irish Aviation Authority at Special Events is on a continuous basis.
