## 5. Legislation

Irish Aviation Authority Act, 1993 “44.—(1) The company may charge such amounts as it considers appropriate in respect of any services (other than services referred to in section 43 ) provided by it, or property, real or personal, sold, hired or leased by it to other persons.

(2) An amount due by a person to the company in respect of a charge under this section may be recovered by the company from the person as a simple contract debt in any court of competent jurisdiction.”

## 6. Fees

There shall be charged and levied for each registration, application, declaration, designation and any associated variations or conversions for the operation of unmanned aircraft, a fee as set out in this schedule:
