AIRCRAFT USED FOR TOWING, PICKING UP AND RAISING OF PERSONS AND ARTICLES, OR PARACHUTE SUPPORT OPERATIONS

The Irish Aviation Authority, in pursuance of Articles 8, 17 and 31 of the Air Navigation (Airworthiness of Aircraft) Order 1996, (S.I. No. 324 of 1996) as amended, hereby directs that where not subject to corresponding and applicable provisions under Commission Regulation (EU) No. 2018/1139, as amended:

- 1. An aircraft shall not be used to tow a glider, banner, or any other object, or pick up or raise any person, animal, or article, unless the type certificate or the flight manual issued in respect of that aircraft by its state of manufacture includes a provision that it may be used for that purpose.
- 2. All modifications required on an aircraft for the purposes of the operations described in paragraph 1 above, or parachute support operations, shall be approved by and incorporated under procedures approved by the Authority or the relevant authority in the state of registry of that aircraft if not registered in the State.
- 3. The above requirements shall apply whether or not the subject operations are conducted as aerial work.
- 4. Replaces Aeronautical Notice Number A.44 at issue 4, which should be discarded.
