Approved Premises (Fuel & Lubricants)

The Irish Aviation Authority (IAA), in pursuance of Articles 6 (1) and 23 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Aerodromes and Visual Ground Aids) Order, 2008, (S.I. No. 355 of 2008), and as directed by Irish Aviation Authority Notice to Aerodrome Licence Holders T.09, as amended, hereby directs that: -

Containers or apparatus used for the storage or delivery of fuel or lubricant to an aircraft, with a capacity of 200 litres or less, are hereby exempt from the requirement, in Aeronautical Notice T.09, to be approved in accordance with Article 27 (3) (b) of the Irish Aviation Authority (Airworthiness of Aircraft) Order, 1996 (324 of 1996).

“Aviation Fuel Installation” means any container or apparatus, including mobile units, designed and manufactured for the storage of aviation fuel and/or equipment for the delivery of such fuel to an aircraft. (Ref: Aeronautical Information Circular AIC Nr 12/00)
