Flights in Egypt airspace, Cairo Flight Information Region (FIR HECC), Sinai Peninsula

The Irish Aviation Authority has been directed by the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport under Section 7 (1) (b) of the Irish Aviation Authority Act 1993 to issue a Direction to Irish AOC carriers that Irish AOC aircraft should not fly below 26,000 feet in Egypt airspace, Cairo Flight Information Region (FIR HECC), Sinai Peninsula.

The Irish Aviation Authority, in pursuance of Articles 4, 7 and 25 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Operations) Order (S.I. No. 61 of 2006) (hereinafter referred to as “the Order”), hereby directs that all Irish AOC aircraft should not fly below 26,000 feet in Egypt’s airspace, Cairo Flight Information Region (FIR HECC), Sinai Peninsula.
