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### **RESTRICTION ON OPERATIONS IN FIR MINSK (UMMV)**

The Irish Aviation Authority, in pursuance of Articles 4 (2), 7 (1) & (3) and Article 9 (1) of the Irish Aviation Authority (Operations) Order, S.I. No. 61 of 2006, hereby directs that aircraft operators holding an air operator certificate issued by the Irish Aviation Authority in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) 965/2012 as amended and aircraft operators having their principal place of business in Ireland shall not conduct operations in FIR Minsk (UMMV), unless the use of that airspace is deemed necessary to ensure safe operation in case of unforeseen circumstances.

Explanatory Note: EASA Safety Directive No. 2021-02 is issued to reduce the potential risk to passengers and crews by avoiding operations in FIR Minsk (UMMV). It requires that EASA Member States competent authorities ensure that aircraft operators having their principal place of business in their territory will not conduct operations in FIR Minsk (UMMV), unless the use of that airspace is deemed necessary to ensure safe operation in case of unforeseen circumstances.
