Use of Aircraft Other Than Those on the Irish National Register For Training at Flying Clubs

Article 4(3) of the Irish Aviation Authority (Operations) Order, 2006 (S.I. 61 of 2006) currently requires that an aircraft owned by or being operated under an agreement entered into by a flying club shall be registered in the State.

Recent changes to the requirements with regard to aircraft maintenance and continuing airworthiness of aircraft introduced by the European Commission have brought into force measures that render this requirement obsolete.

The Irish Aviation Authority therefore directs that the requirements as set out in Article 4(3) of the (Operations) Order shall no longer apply to an aircraft owned by or being operated under an agreement entered into by a flying club. The contents of the (Operations) Order will be amended to reflect the change in due course.
