RENEWAL OF AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE ENGINEERS LICENCES

GENERAL

The Irish Aviation authority, with reference to the Irish Aviation Authority (Personnel Licensing) Orders, 2000 to 2003 and in pursuance of articles 4 and 9 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Personnel Licensing) Order 2000 (S.I. No. 333 of 2000) as amended, hereby directs that the validity period for an "Aircraft Maintenance Licence" and any aircraft maintenance licence ratings shall not exceed 24 months.

APPLICATION

The application for renewal of an "Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence" should be made on a renewal application form which may be obtained from the Personnel Licensing Section, Regulatory Performance and Personnel Licensing Department (RPPL), Irish Aviation Authority, Aviation House, Hawkins Street, Dublin 2, or from www.iaa.ie. On completion, this form should be returned together with the licence book and the prescribed fee.

With effect from 28th September 2010 aircraft maintenance licences issued in accordance with the above Order(s) shall cease to be valid for certification of release to service of aircraft or aircraft products to which EC 216 of 2008 (as amended), applies.

Persons wishing to convert their national aircraft maintenance licence to an EASA part-66 aircraft maintenance licence (AML) should apply to the above address on EASA form 19 (available from www.iaa.ie) enclosing their current national licence and the appropriate fee. All applications for conversion of national licences to EASA part-66 licence should be applied for not later than Friday 30th June 2010.
