**RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 6 (1) and 23 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Aerodromes and Visual Ground Aids) Order, 2008, (S.I. No. 355 of 2008), hereby directs as follows:-

An aerodrome licence holder for an aerodrome licensed for public use shall ensure that the following requirements are complied with;

1. In the event that rescue and fire fighting services are not available at an aerodrome, as required in accordance with Chapter 9 of Annex 14 and Chapter 10 of the IAA Aerodrome Licensing Manual (ALM 002), the aerodrome shall be notified by NOTAM as closed to commercial transport aircraft.
2. A change to the normal aerodrome category for rescue and fire fighting (as defined in Annex 14 and ALM 002 ) shall also be promulgated by NOTAM, except where the change is for a period of less than 1 hour and aircraft intending to land or take-off at that aerodrome are advised accordingly by the local ATS unit.
