FLIGHT RESTRICTION NOTICE

Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Galway Racecourse Ballybrit, County Galway Monday 28th July to Sunday 03rd August, 2025 inclusive

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 and 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Standardised Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows: -

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) as defined in S.I. No. 24 of 2023 and European Commission Regulation (EU) 2019/947, shall apply in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits: Circle radius of 0.75NM centred on 53° 17' 41" N,

008° 59' 41" W.

Vertical limits: SFC to 1500 feet AMSL

Duration: The period of the restriction shall be from 0900hrs UTC to

1900hrs UTC daily from Monday 28th July to Sunday 03rd

August, 2025 inclusive.

The Purpose of the TRA:

The purpose of the TRA is to ensure the safety of aircraft operating to and from the Galway Racecourse and of other air traffic operating in the vicinity at Ballybrit, County Galway in the period cited.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA is classified as ICAO Class G. The TRA is located within the Shannon Flight Information Region (FIR). There is no dedicated communications service within the TRA or HAMMS. For flights operating to and from the TRA, Air Traffic Services, as appropriate, are provided by AirNav Ireland at Shannon ACC (AIP refers).

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted in the TRA.

- i. State aircraft (including State Unmanned Aircraft Systems), aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service, Aircraft Operators employed on an operational HEMS mission, shall be exempt from the restriction.
- ii. Flights by aircraft, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems, authorised by the controlling authority.
- iii. Rockets, with specific written permission from the Authority and the controlling authority.

b. Flights not permitted in the TRA.

- Flights by all other aircraft, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems, and rockets, are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations or permissions, other than those listed at 'a. Flights Permitted in the TRA' granted to aircraft, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems, and rockets, by the Authority, are not valid within the TRA during the periods cited.
- iii. Any aircraft, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems, directed by the Authority not to enter the TRA, including aircraft already authorised as a permitted flight by the Flying Display Director as per a.ii.

Pursuant to Article 13 of S.I. No. 24 of 2023, where there is a suspected breach of the EASA Regulations, or the Order (S.I. No. 24 of 2023), a member of An Garda Síochána may, in accordance with Section 7 of the Criminal Justice Act 2006, detain the Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

Pursuant to Article 22 of S.I. No. 24 of 2023, if it appears to a member of An Garda Siochana, that a Unmanned Aircraft Systems is likely to be operated in contravention of the EASA Regulation, the IAA Act 1993, the Order (S.I. No. 24 of 2023), or any Directions thereunder, or if a member of An Garda Síochána reasonably suspects the Unmanned Aircraft Systems is being, or is intended to be operated in the commission of any offence, they may direct the operator or remote pilot, not to operate the Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course by the AIS office to notify of the TRA activation.
