FLIGHT RESTRICTION NOTICE

IRISH AVIATION AUTHORITY THE TIMES BUILDING 11-12 D'OLIER STREET DUBLIN 2

Temporary Restricted Area (TRA) in the vicinity of Stradbally Hall, Stradbally, County Laois
Wednesday August 27th to Tuesday September 2nd, 2025.

The Irish Aviation Authority (IAA) in pursuance of Articles 7 and 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Standardised Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows: -

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) as defined in S.I. No. 24 of 2023 and European Commission Regulation (EU) 2019/947, shall apply within the following volume of airspace:

Lateral limits: Circle radius of 2.0 NM centred on

53° 00' 33" N, 007° 09' 58" W

Vertical limits: SFC to 2000FT AMSL.

Duration: The period of the restriction shall be from 0500hrs UTC on

Wednesday August 27th to 0800hrs UTC on Tuesday September 2nd,

2025.

The Purpose of the TRA:

The purpose of the TRA, within which flight restrictions may apply, is to ensure the safety of aircraft operating into and out of the Electric Picnic Music Festival, Stradbally Hall, Stradbally County Laois and of other aircraft operating in the vicinity of the TRA in the period cited.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA is classified as ICAO Class G. The TRA is located within the Shannon Flight Information Region (FIR). There is no dedicated communications service within the TRA. For flights operating to and from the TRA, Air Traffic Services for the FIR are as published in the IAIP.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS aircraft employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.
- ii. Subject to any decision by the IAA to the contrary, the airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the event organisers (EP Republic Ltd).

b. Flights not permitted.

- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at 'a. Flights Permitted' granted to civil general air traffic by the IAA, are not valid within the TRA during the periods cited.
- iii. Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) including drones and rockets, may not operate within the TRA without specific written permission from the IAA and event organisers (EP Republic Ltd).
- iv. UAS's operated in breach of TRA restrictions may be subject to seizure by An Garda Síochána as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of aviation safety.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the TRA activation.
