



Flight Restriction in the vicinity of County Clare Coastline

Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Article 7 paragraphs 3 and 6, and Article 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Standardised Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (Statutory Instrument (S.I.) No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited areas and Restricted areas), hereby directs as follows:-

A temporary restriction on the flying of aircraft, and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, shall apply in the temporary restricted area (TRA) contained within the volume of airspace defined below:

Lateral limits: The airspace contained within:

Arc radius of 28KM/15.12NM centred on
52° 46' 10.85"N, 009° 30' 03.76" W

52° 48' 27.40" N, 009° 32' 25.92" W
Arc radius of 5KM/2.7NM centred on
52° 46' 10.85"N, 009° 30' 03.76" W
52° 45' 23.14" N, 009° 34' 18.47" W

Vertical limits: SFC to 2500FT AMSL

***Duration:** The period of the restriction shall be from 1000hrs UTC to 1700hrs UTC Monday to Friday from Friday March 6th to Friday June 5th, 2026, excluding St. Patrick's Day (Tuesday March 17th, 2026), Easter Monday (Monday April 6th, 2026), May Day Bank Holiday (Monday May 4th, 2026), and June Bank Holiday (Monday June 1st, 2026).

Airspace Classification: ICAO Class G

The purpose of the TRA is to ensure the safety of aircraft operating within and of other air traffic operating in the vicinity of the County Clare coastline in the period cited whilst allowing for Unmanned Aircraft System testing.

Subject to any decision of the Irish Aviation Authority to the contrary, the airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by A-Techsyn Ltd.

State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the activation of the TRA.

Temporary Restricted Area - In the vicinity of County Clare Coastline


