FLIGHT RESTRICTION NOTICE

Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Abbeyleix, Co, Laois

Sunday 29th June 2025

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 & 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923 of 2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:

Temporary restrictions (Temporary Restricted Areas) on the flying of aircraft, rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, and Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) as defined in S.I. No. 24 of 2023 and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/947, shall apply in the vicinity of Abbeyleix, County Laois in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits: Circle radius of 2.0 NM centered on

52° 53' 40" N, 007° 22' 09" W

Vertical limits: SFC to 2000 feet AMSL.

Duration: The period of the restriction shall be from 0900hrs UTC to 1700hrs UTC on Sunday 29th June 2025.

The purpose of the TRAs is to allow Abbeyleix Air Display to take place whilst ensuring to safeguard the safety of competitors and spectators in the vicinity of Abbeyleix, County Laois in the period cited.

The airspace contained within the TRAs shall be classified as ICAO Class G.

The controlling authority for the TRAs is An Garda Síochána. The contact details are as outlined in the TRA Flight Restriction Notice published on the IAA website for the event.

State aircraft (including State Unmanned Aircraft Systems), aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service, HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission, and aircraft including Unmanned Aircraft Systems authorised by the controlling authority, shall be exempt from the restriction.

Pursuant to Article 13 of S.I. No. 24 of 2023, where there is a suspected breach of the EASA Regulations, or the Order (S.I. No. 24 of 2023), a member of An Garda Síochána may, in accordance with Section 7 of the Criminal Justice Act 2006, detain the UAS.

Pursuant to Article 22 of S.I. No. 24 of 2023, if it appears to a member of An Garda Siochana, that a UAS is likely to be operated in contravention of the EASA Regulation, the IAA Act 1993, the Order (S.I. No. 24 of 2023), or any Directions thereunder, or if a member of An Garda Siochána reasonably suspects the UAS is being, or is intended to be operated in the commission of any offence, they may direct the operator or remote pilot, not to operate the UAS.


Pursuant to Section 7 of Criminal Justice Act 2006, a member of An Garda Síochána may take such steps as are necessary to detain that UAS at a suitable location.

Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions granted to UAS Operators, are not valid within these Temporary Restricted Areas during the period cited.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the TRA activation.
