



**Temporary Restricted Area (TRA) in the vicinity of
Shannon Airport and Doonbeg Golf Course, County Clare,
On Friday 11th September 2026 to Saturday 12th September 2026**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 & 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923 of 2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:

Temporary restrictions (Temporary Restricted Areas) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, shall apply in the vicinity of Shannon Airport and Doonbeg Golf Course, County Clare in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

TRA 1

Lateral limits:

A circle radius of 15NM centred on:
N524207 W0085529

Vertical limits:

SFC to 5000FT AMSL

Duration:

Friday 11th September 2026 to Saturday 12th September 2026. The period of restriction shall be from 0430hrs UTC on Friday 11th September to 1130hrs UTC on Saturday 12th September 2026.

A circle radius of 10NM centred on:
N524447 W0093012

Vertical limits:

SFC to 5000FT AMSL

Duration:

Friday 11th September 2026 to Saturday 12th September 2026. The period of restriction shall be from 0430hrs UTC on Friday 11th September to 1230hrs UTC on Saturday 12th September 2026.

The Purpose of the TRAs:

The purpose of the TRA is for reasons of security, by the Department of Justice, Home Affairs and Migration in the vicinity of Shannon Airport and Doonbeg Golf Club, County Clare.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA's is classified as ICAO Class C. The TRA is located within the Shannon CTR/Shannon CTA and Shannon FIR.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction including flights authorised by the controlling authority.
- ii. All scheduled commercial arrivals and departures at Shannon Airport are exempt.
- iii. **Controlling Authority:** Department of Justice, Home Affairs and Migration, 51 St Stephens Green, D2, coflights@justice.ie

b. Flights not permitted.

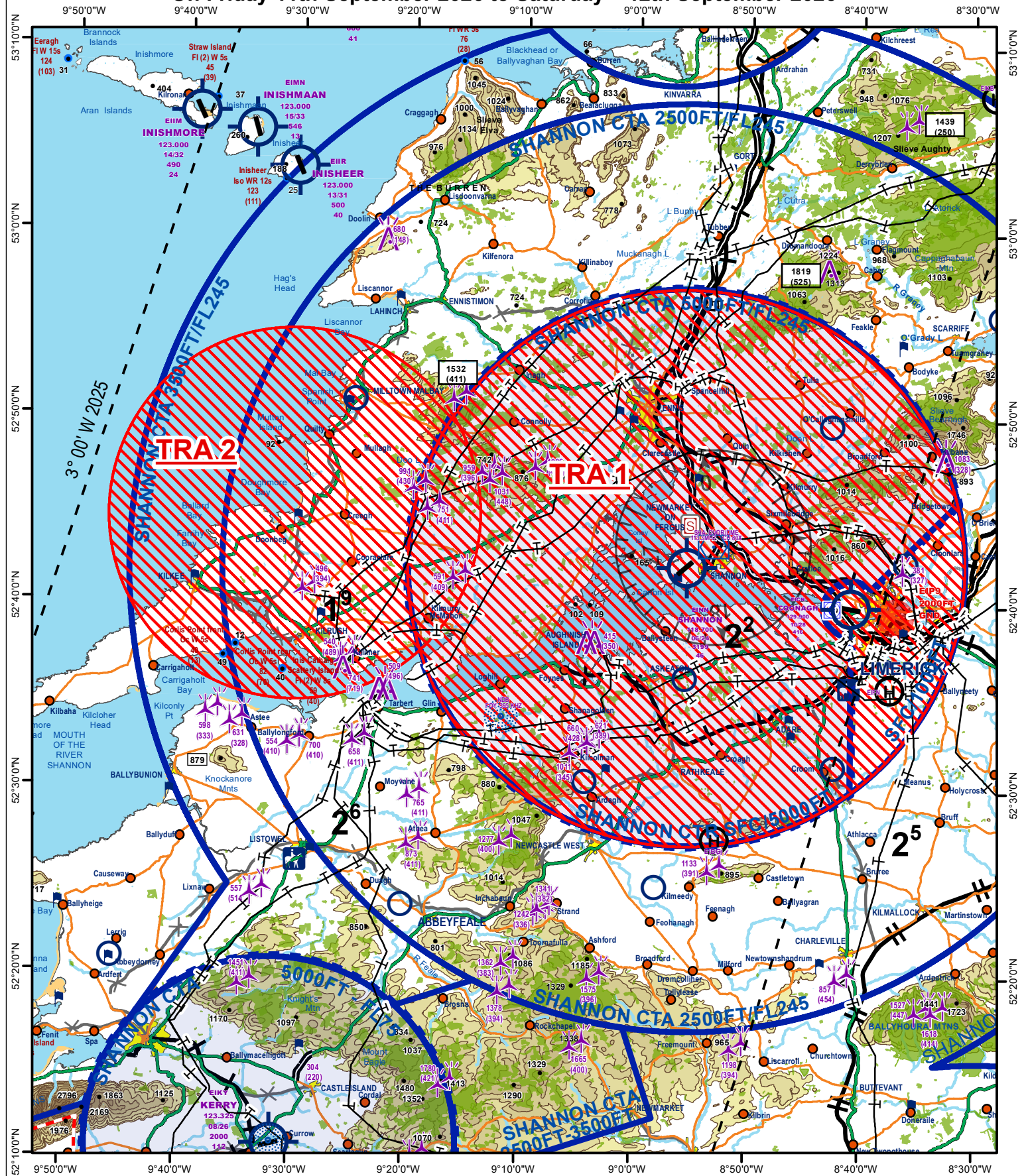
- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at '**a. Flights Permitted**' granted to civil general air traffic by the controlling Authority, are not valid within the TRAs during the periods cited.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course by the AIS office to notify of the TRA activation.
