



**Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Galway Racecourse
Ballybrit, County Galway
Monday 27th July to Sunday 02nd August inclusive 2026**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 and 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Standardised Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows: -

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, shall apply in the vicinity of Galway Racecourse, Ballybrit, County Galway, in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:	Circle radius of 0.75NM centred on 53° 17' 41" N, 008° 59' 41" W.
Vertical limits:	SFC to 1500 feet AMSL
Duration:	The period of the restriction shall be from 0900hrs UTC to 1900hrs UTC daily from Monday 27 th July to Sunday 02 nd August 2026 inclusive.
Controlling Authority:	Galway Garda station, Mill St, Galway - Inspector Darragh Browne, 091 538008, Galway.DV@garda.ie

The Purpose of the TRA:

The purpose of the TRA is to ensure the security of the Galway Racecourse in the vicinity at Ballybrit, Co. Galway in the period cited.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA is classified as ICAO Class G. The TRA is located within the Shannon Flight Information Region (FIR). There is no dedicated communications service within the TRA.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS aircraft operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.
- ii. The airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the controlling authority (Galway Garda station, Mill St, Galway - Inspector Darragh Browne, 091 538008, Galway.DV@garda.ie).
- iii. Landing aircraft require permission from Galway Garda station, Mill St, Galway - Inspector Darragh Browne, 091 538008, Galway.DV@garda.ie

b. Flights not permitted.

- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at '**a. Flights Permitted**' granted to civil general air traffic by the Authority, are not valid within the TRAs during the periods cited.

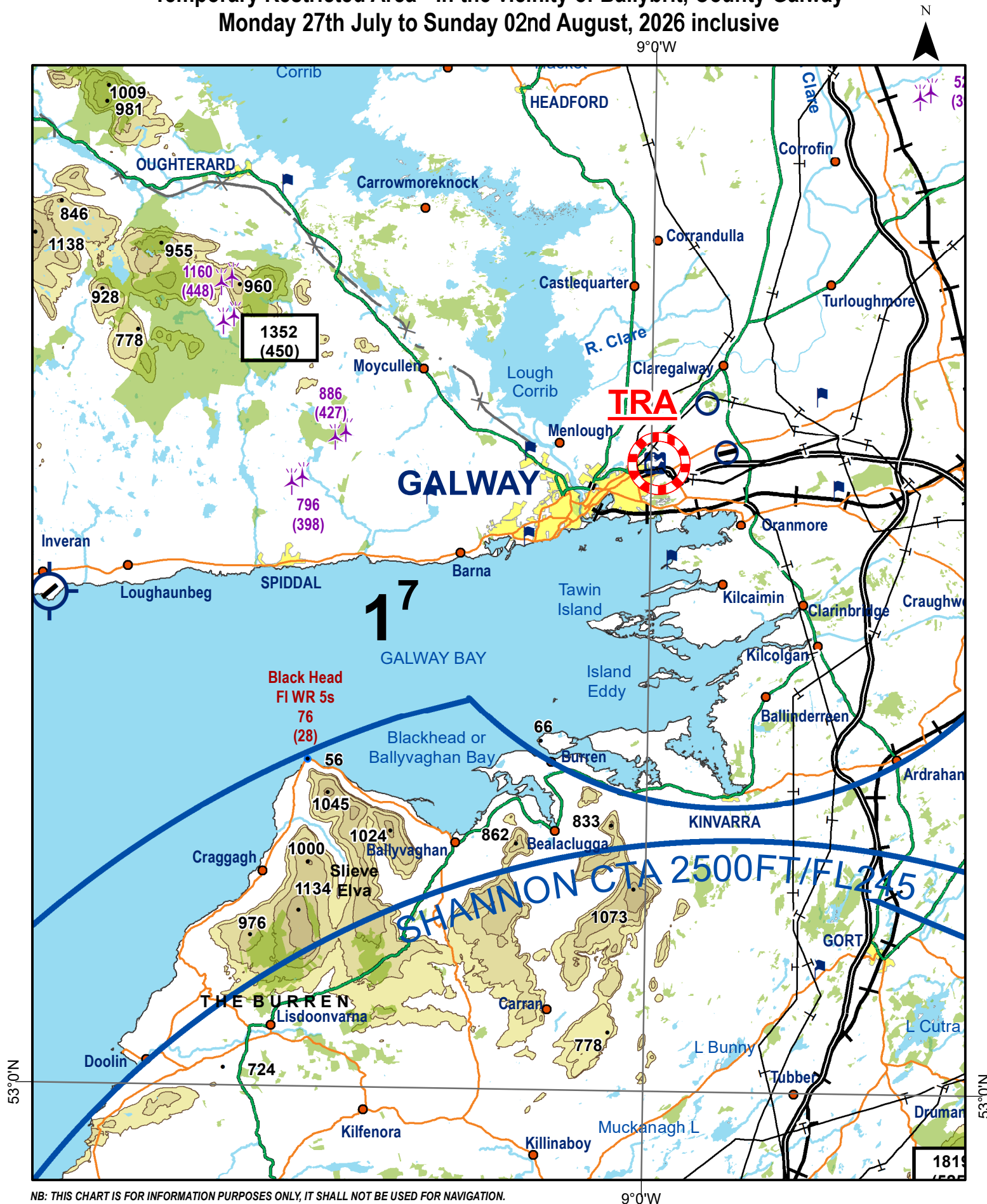
A NOTAM will be issued in due course by the AIS office to notify of the TRA activation.
