
**Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Slane, County Meath
Saturday July 18th and Sunday July 19th, 2026**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 & 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019) and in accordance with European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:-

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, shall apply in the vicinity of Slane Castle, County Meath in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:	Circle radius of 1.0NM centred on 53°42'36.7" N, 006°33'35.2" W
Vertical limits:	SFC to 3000 feet AMSL
Duration:	The period of the restriction shall be daily from 1200hrs UTC to 2300hrs UTC on Saturday July 18 th and Sunday July 19 th , 2026

The Purpose of the TRAs:

The Minister of Transport acceding to a request from The Department of Justice for reasons related to security, has directed the Irish Aviation Authority to establish an area of Temporary Restricted Airspace (TRA) within which flight restrictions shall apply as detailed hereafter.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA is classified as ICAO Class C. The TRA is located within the Dublin CTA.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction including flights authorised by the controlling authority (An Garda Síochána, Navan, Co Meath).
- ii. All scheduled commercial traffic to/from Dublin are exempt (including MAPs)

b. Flights not permitted.

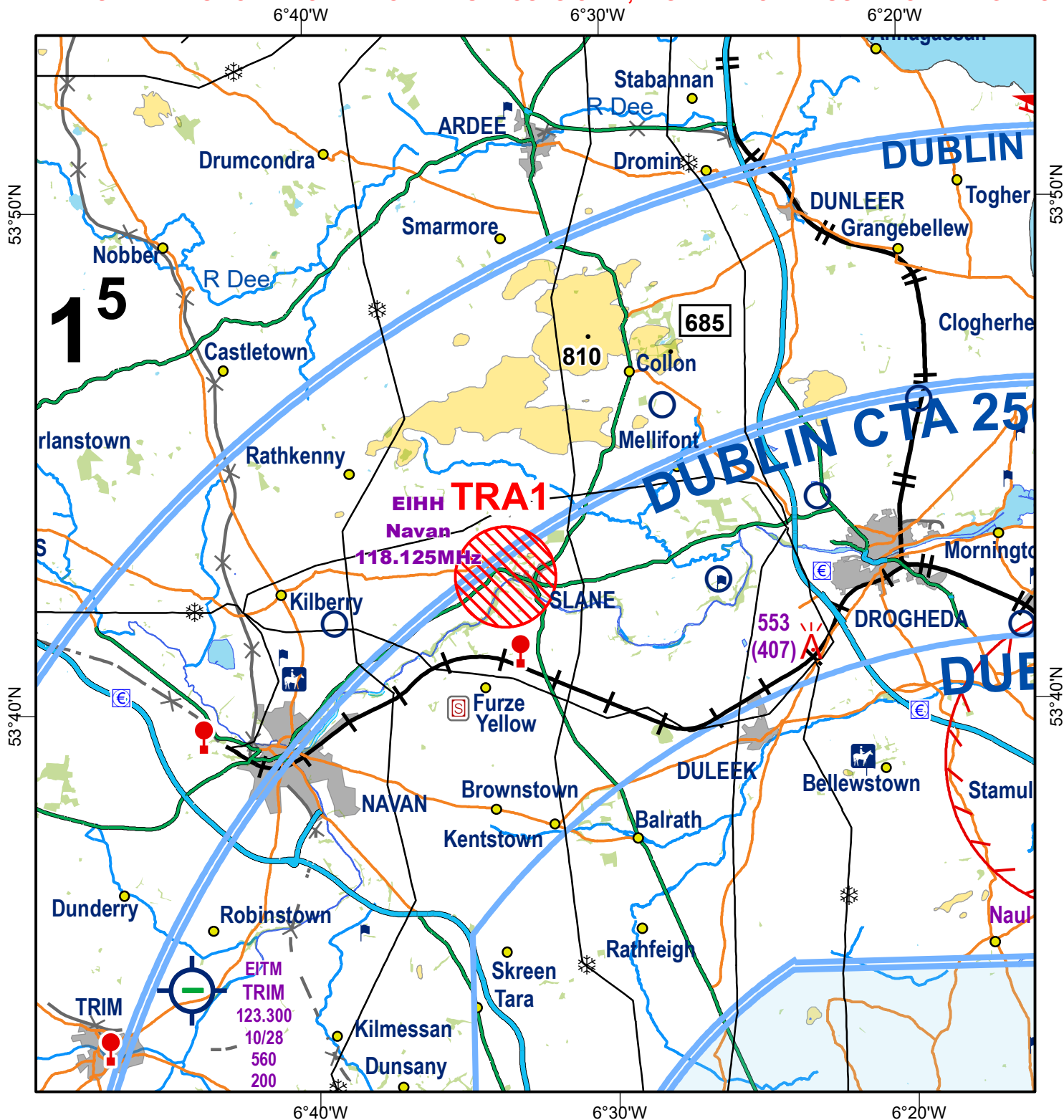
- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at '**a. Flights Permitted**' granted to civil general air traffic by the Irish Aviation Authority, are not valid within the TRAs during the periods cited.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the TRA activation.
