



**Flight Restriction off the Cork Coastline,
Thursday 02nd July to Friday 03rd July 2026**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 & 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923 of 2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:

Temporary restrictions (Temporary Restricted Areas) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, shall apply off the Cork Coastline in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:

51°41'33.59"N 008°28'36.88"W
51°34'52.67"N 008°58'35.31"W
51°20'22.55"N 008°51'53.28"W
51°25'46.19"N 008°21'40.67"W

Vertical Limits:

SFC / 3000FT

Duration:

The period of the restriction shall be from 0800hrs UTC
Thursday 2nd July to 1900hrs UTC Friday 3rd July.

The Purpose of the TRAs:

The purpose of the TRA is for State Security.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA retains its ICAO Classification.

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction including flights authorised by the controlling authority (Ireland Defence Forces).
- ii. Subject to any decision by the Flight Operations Department of the Irish Aviation Authority to the contrary, the airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the controlling authority (Ireland Defence Forces).
- iii. All scheduled commercial arrivals and departures at Cork Airport are exempt (including MAPs).

b. Flights not permitted.

- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at '**a. Flights Permitted**' granted to civil general air traffic by the Authority, are not valid within the TRAs during the periods cited.
- iii. Rockets, may not operate within the TRAs without specific written permission from the Flight Operations Department and controlling authority (Ireland Defence Forces).
- iv. Pursuant to Section 7 of Criminal Justice Act 2006, a member of An Garda Síochána may take such steps as are necessary to detain that UAS at a suitable location.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course by the AIS office to notify of the TRA activation.

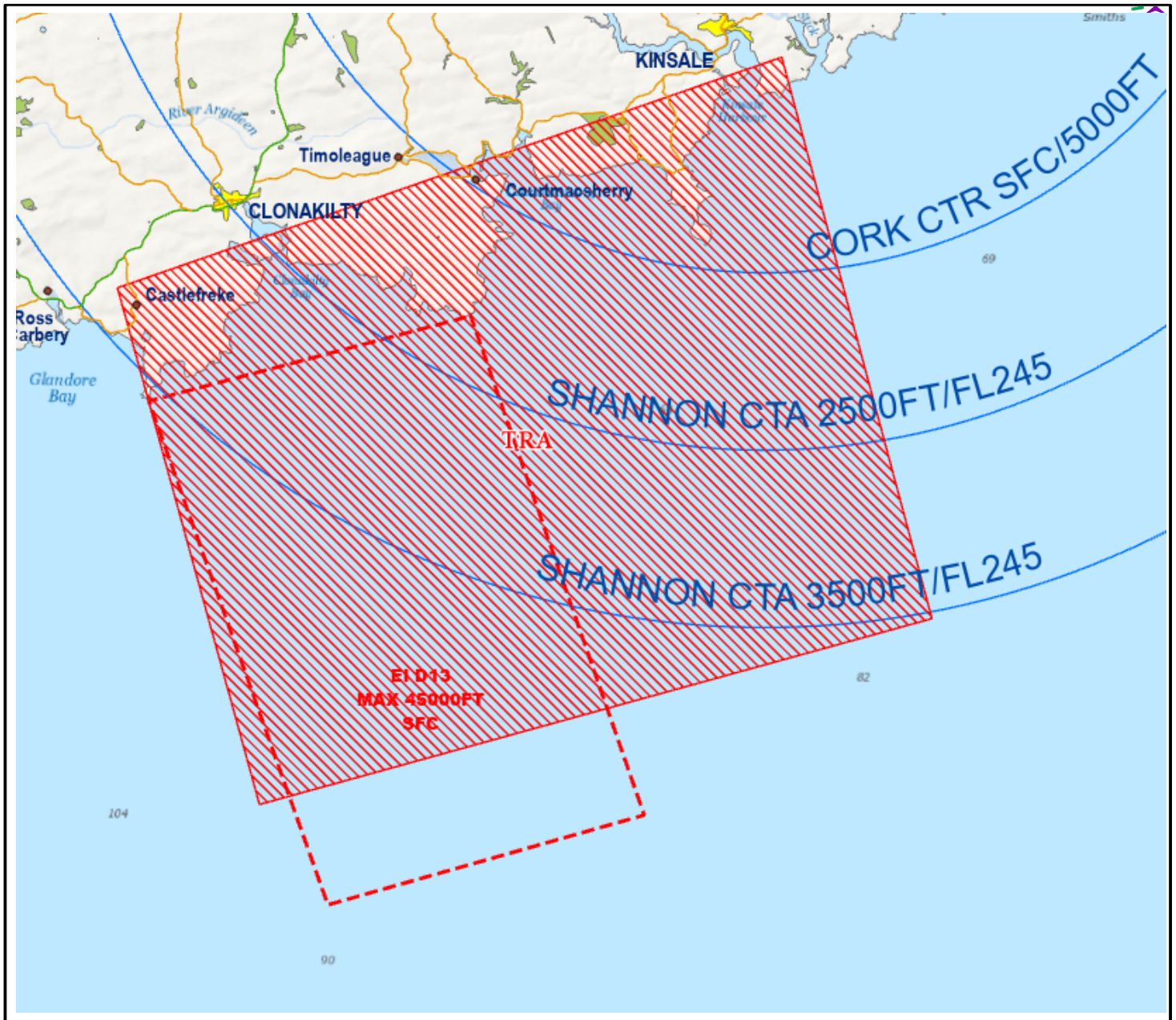
