I understand that the Exemption granted will be restricted to Glass "G" Airspace only and will prohibit flight above 5,000 ft. AMSL or in Controlled Airspace or at night or carrying a passenger. It will also prohibit flight over a town or built-up area or any open air assembly of people at any height. I hereby make application for Exemption from Article 5 of the IAA (Personnel Licensing) Order, 2000 (SI No. 333 of 2000).

Guidance Notes

In order for the IAA to process your application as quickly as possible, it is important that you complete the application form correctly. Please complete the form in conjunction with the following guidance notes.

Section 1 – Personal Details

Please ensure that your First Name(s) are entered **exactly** as per the 'evidence of identity' document that you submit with your application - see Submission instructions at the end of this form.

The permanent address will be entered on your exemption, and will also be the address to which the exemption will be sent. If you want the exemption sent to an alternative address, please enter the details under 'correspondence address'.

Section 2 – Details of foreign FLPA Licence / Qualification held

Section 3 - Application

Please indicate the FLPA rating(s) for which you are applying. If you are not sure which one you may qualify for please contact the IAA.

Note:- a valid ICAO Class 1 or Class 2 medical certificate will be accepted for the initial issue of an FLPA exemption. For any subsequent exemptions, an initial Part-FCL Class 1 or Class 2 medical examination must be completed in Ireland, and a valid Part-FCL medical certificate held in order to continue exercising flying privileges.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The IAA will not normally require a skill test to be completed for the issuance of an exemption for an FLPA. However, if the IAA is unable to determine the validity of the licence/qualification or the flying hours are considered inadequate, then a skill test may be required. A skill test may also be required where the applicant's original licence/qualification is issued by a State/qualified entity with a FLPA licensing system that the IAA is unfamiliar with.
